

Run a container with kubectl

In Docker you can run a one-time container with the following

```
docker run --rm -it centos /bin/bash
```

To use the same in Kubernetes you need to use kubectl in any cluster

```
kubectl run tmp-shell --restart=Never --rm -i --tty --image centos -- /bin/bash
```
